## **45th Anniversary Matching Challenge**

We are pleased to share that we met the initial matching goal in our 45th anniversary gift campaign. As a result, all contributions are now being matched dollar for dollar, immediately DOUBLING your impact.

Thanks to strong early support, the first \$15,000 goal was reached, prompting the donation of \$15,000 in matching funds. The generous donor will continue to match new contributions up to an additional \$45,000 in honor of our 45th anniversary through March 31. In total, Wood Hudson may receive up to \$60,000 in matching funds to further strengthen our cancer research and undergraduate education programs.

## **Exciting Early Progress in Dr. Gehret's Research**

Dr. Mary Kate Gehret is leading research focused on targeting mutant KRAS which plays an important role in colorectal cancer. In cancer, mutations in the KRAS gene cause the KRAS protein to become overactive, which can lead to uncontrolled cell growth. Her work is helping researchers better understand how this gene contributes to cancer development and how it may be addressed through future treatment strategies.

She is partnering with her former advisor at the University of Cincinnati James L. Winkle College of Pharmacy, Dr. Joan Garrett, to advance this research through the analysis of samples using advanced genetic testing methods. This collaboration is providing deeper insights and helping guide the next phase of the project.


