## Generous Donation from Chemed Foundation



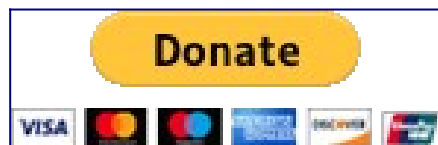
