2024 American Association for Cancer Research Annual Meeting

for Cancer Research®

This year, the American Association for Cancer Research's (AACR) annual meeting will be held at the San Diego Convention Center in San Diego, California, from April 5-10. According to the AACR, American Association the annual meeting is "the focal point of the cancer research community, where scientists, clinicians, other health care professionals, survivors, patients, and advocates gather to share

the latest advances in cancer science and medicine." Fortunately for Wood Hudson Cancer Research Laboratory scientists, major portions of the AACR Annual Meeting are being livestreamed and will be available for viewing remotely. Wood Hudson scientists have participated in the AACR's Annual Meetings by presenting their latest research almost every year since 1985. Most recently, we have given reports on our bladder cancer, ovarian cancer and breast cancer research projects.

While Wood Hudson scientists will not be physically present this year, the AACR is expecting a record number of attendees, featuring more than 7,200 abstracts, more than 50 major symposia, nearly 300 poster sessions, and over a dozen forums and special sessions, as well as numerous focused and plenary sessions. On April 5th and 6th, prior to the Annual Meeting opening plenary session on Sunday, April 7th, two days of educational sessions will be held. All scientific sessions held in the Convention Center will be live streamed and attended virtually by Wood Hudson scientists.

Cancer scientists at all levels are able to gain new knowledge about the latest developments in the field thanks to the AACR annual meeting. From students and undergraduates, to professors and research scientists, the collective expertise at this event can inspire scientific creativity as we share our new discoveries and learn from one another, for the benefit of cancer patients worldwide.
