

Newport's East Row Historic District Supports UREP Students

HISTORIC DISTRICT The East Row Historic District of Newport, Kentucky, is the second largest historic district in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, created by joining the two districts Mansion Hill and Gateway. The East Row Historic Foundation is a Non-Profit organization with the mission of bettering the neighborhood by promoting historic preservation, civic engagement, and social events. This spring, they have chosen to support breast cancer research and local students in the community with a generous grant of \$2000 for our Undergraduate Research Education Program (UREP). This grant will fund student salaries, and matching funds of \$2000 will be supplied by the lab for research supplies. Wood Hudson Cancer Research Laboratory currently has five students having an experiential learning experience in our laboratory, continuing the educational mission of the Corpus Christi school in this neighborhood. Breast cancer is a leading cause of death in women in Northern Kentucky and elsewhere in the US. Many former UREP students have become physicians, nurses, and teachers now serving our community.

Two Gatton Academy Students to Participate in Summer 2023 UREP

This summer, our Undergraduate Research Education Program (UREP) will include two students from the Gatton Academy of Mathematics and Science. Students attending their last two years of high school at Gatton Academy earn college credits at Western Kentucky University. Their salaries will be supported in part by a generous grant from WKU's College Heights Foundation. Gatton Academy students have been participating in Wood Hudson's UREP program for over ten years. Many of the Gatton Academy students have gone on to careers in science and medicine. Students come from all across Kentucky to The Gatton Academy on the campus of Western Kentucky University, enrolling at WKU during their junior and senior years in high school to pursue interests, education, and careers in advanced science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.
